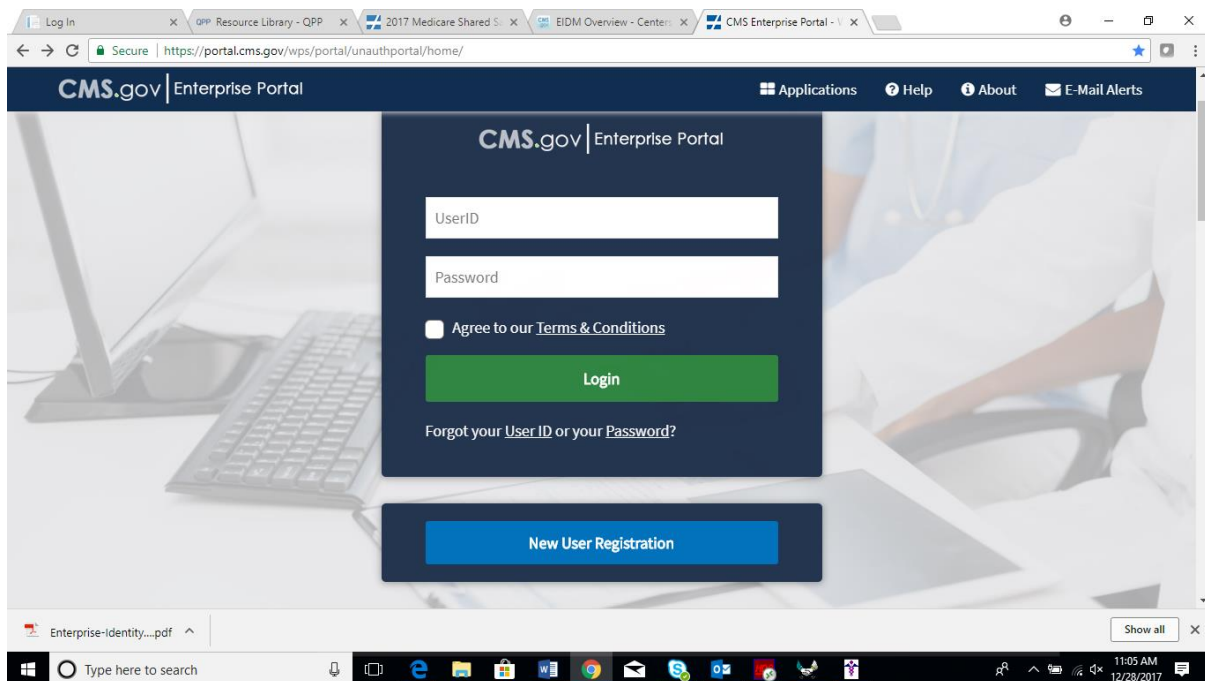


Create a Username and Password.

Access <https://portal.cms.gov>, then click New User Registration. Complete requested information by creating a user and password. Once you have completed this registration, an email will be sent to you re: your enrollment. Click on email and acknowledge. Your user and password is now active. 
Attesting for MIPS
